The Society of Actuaries introduces the

Academic Exam Fee Reimbursement Program

University and college faculty members and Ph.D. students who are considering becoming credentialed actuaries now have more of a monetary incentive to do so! Beginning November 1, 2008, the SOA will reimburse certain exam and assessment fees for successful full-time faculty members and graduate students enrolled in Ph.D. programs. These fees have often been a barrier to faculty members and Ph.D. students who would like to take exams to receive their designations, but choose not to due to lack of monetary support.

Now, in addition to the SOA's University Grant Program and the Ph.D. Grant Competition, the Society is establishing the Academic Exam Fee Reimbursement Program designed to help reduce the exam fee barrier and provide encouragement to those considering SOA membership.

The following exams and assessments passed after November 1, 2008 will be eligible for fee reimbursement under the Academic Exam Fee Reimbursement Program. Please note that this applies to successful attempts only:

- Exam MLC
- Exam MFE
- Exam C
- FAP Assessments—initially downloaded after Nov. 1, 2008
- Fellowship-level exams

Eligibility Requirements*

UNIVERSITY AND COLLEGE FACULTY MEMBERS:

- Must be full-time faculty member with an accredited university or college.
- Must have passed Exams P and FM.
- Must have passing result on exam(s) or assessment(s) submitted for reimbursement.

GRADUATE PH.D. STUDENTS:

- Must be enrolled full-time in a Ph.D. program.
- Cannot have other substantial employment outside the university.
- Must hold a master's degree.
- Must have passed Exams P and FM.
- Must have passing result on exam(s) or assessment(s) submitted for reimbursement.
