- Material covered since midterm 3 (namely, ANOVA and regression) definitely will appear on the final.
- The final also is cumulative. All material mentioned in the descriptions of the midterms could also appear on the final. Topics that didn't appear on the midterms are especially likely to be on the final.
- Questions will be mostly short answer and multiple choice. Some will involve using formulas. Others will involve interpreting SAS output that I will provide.
- You may use:
 - up to four 8-1/2 x 11 sheets of paper with your own notes (the three from your midterms, plus one more)
 - the normal, t, and chi square tables from your textbook
 - a calculator
- Short answer questions and interpretation of computer output will be similar in style to homework problems. Doing unassigned textbook problems would be an excellent way to prepare for the exam.

The final exam will be taken on the honor system. You are expected to complete the exam using only your sheets of notes and the tables listed above. Once you begin, the midterm will be strictly limited to 2 hours, so you will not have time to consult your textbook, lecture notes, the Internet, or other sources. If you prepare well and have made careful note sheets, you should be fine.
